This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.S.Ramachandrapradeep, Advocate for the petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the state, this court passed the following:

**Order**

1. Bail application u/s 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS).

2. Heard both sides.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that the respondent police has registered a case in Crime No.11/2026 for the offences u/s 296(b), 109 and 351(3) of BNS against the petitioner. The respondent police arrested the petitioner and remanded to judicial custody on 12.02.2026 and is in custody for the past 33 days. The petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offences as alleged. The defacto-complainant and the petitioner are brothers. Due to previous enmity in the matter of property dispute, the present false complaint is lodged. Injured discharged from hospital. The petitioner has not filed similar petition before the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court or any other court. The petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions that would be imposed by this Court and prayed to allow the petition.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that it is a case of single accused, who is the petitioner herein. As per the case of the prosecution, the defacto-complainant and the petitioner are brothers. Their mother refused to transfer the properties in the name of the petitioner and in that enmity, on 10.02.2026 at 11.00 a.m., the petitioner abused their mother in vulgar words and assaulted her with wooden log and Aruval and caused injuries and also threatened her with dire consequences and left. Hence, the case. Injured discharged from hospital on 13.02.2026. Investigation is pending and objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Rival contentions are taken into consideration. The alleged offences against the petitioner/accused are u/s 296(b), 109 and 351(3) of BNS. The occurrence is said to have taken place on 10.02.2026. It seems that the defacto-complainant and the petitioner are brothers and that the injured is their mother. Injured discharged from hospital on 13.02.2026. The petitioner is in custody for 33 days. Material part of investigation has been completed. No previous case is reported against the petitioner. Considering all these aspects, the discharge of injured, the relationship between the parties, the duress period of petitioner and the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner on conditions.

In the result, the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate No.II, Usilampatti subject to the following conditions:-

(i) After release, the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Inspector of police, Tirumangalam Town police station **daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders.**

(ii) The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigation and shall not threaten the witnesses and shall not cause hindrance to the pending investigation.

(iii) That the petitioner shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected and

(iv) If there is any violation of condition, the Investigation Officer is within his discretion to approach the Court of the learned Judicial Magistrate, concerned for cancellation of bail as per the ruling of the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in **P.K.Shaji/Vs/State of Kerala, (2005) AIR S.C.W.5560.**
