This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.A.Pandisumath, Advocate for the petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

Order

1. Bail application u/s 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS).

2. Heard both sides.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that the respondent police has registered a case against the petitioner in Crime No.299/2025 for the offences u/s 465, 468 & 471 of IPC. The petitioner was arrested by the respondent police and remanded to judicial custody on 06.03.2026 and is in custody for the past 13 days. The petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offences as alleged. The petitioner has not filed similar petition before the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court or any other court. The petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions that would be imposed by this Court and prayed to allow the petition.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that it is a case of single accused, who is the petitioner herein. As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner is the owner of vehicle bearing Registration No.TN-59-BY-5938. The petitioner has committed fraud and forgery by way of counterfeit insurance policy. Hence, the

complaint. The case has been transferred to EOW and hence prayed to dismiss the petition.

5. Rival contentions are taken into consideration. The alleged offences against the petitioner/accused are u/s 465, 468 & 471 of IPC. As per prosecution, investigation is transferred to EOW. Hence, the petition is dismissed on this aspect.

In the result, the petition is dismissed.
