This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.P. Kaviarasan, Advocate for the petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

Order

1. Petition to relax the Condition.
2. The offences alleged are u/s 191(2), 191(3), 296(b), 132, 118(1), 109 and 351(3) of BNS.
3. Heard both sides.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was granted bail by this court as per order in CrI.M.P.No.1012/2026 dated 06.03.2026 in respect of Crime No.39/2026 of respondent P.S. on conditions to stay in Villupuram District and to appear and sign before the Inspector of Police, Villupuram Town police station daily at 10.00 a.m. and 05.00 p.m. until further orders. The said condition was modified by this court as per order in Cr.M.P.No.1323/2026 dated 27.03.2026 directing the petitioner to stay in Tanjore District and appear and sign before the Inspector of Police, Tanjore Taluk police station daily at 10.00 a.m. and 05.00 p.m. until further orders. The petitioner regularly complied with the modified condition for 26 days before Tanjore Taluk Police Station and thereafter, the said condition was further modified as per order of this court in Cr.M.P.No.1469/2026 dated 08.04.2026 directing the petitioner to appear and sign before the Inspector of police, Sivagangai Town police station daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders and

the petitioner complied with the said condition for 37 days. Thereafter, the said condition was modified by this court as per order in Cr.M.P.No.1625/2026 dated 21.04.2026 directing the petitioner to appear and sign before the Inspector of police, Sivagangai Town police station weekly once. i.e. on every Monday at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner is regularly complying with the modified condition for the past 8 weeks. Investigation is almost completed. The petitioner is the only earning member in his family and he finds it difficult to comply with the condition and hence, it is prayed to relax the condition. The learned Public Prosecutor has not denied the number of days of compliance of condition by the petitioner. He further stated that co-accused are still observing the condition and that charge sheet is not yet filed and opposed to relax the condition. Considering the above facts, the number of days of compliance of condition by the petitioner, the reasons assigned by the petitioner and also the nature of offences, the non-filing of charge sheet and the objections placed on the side of prosecution, this court is not inclined to relax the condition, but modified the condition.

In the result, the petition is partly allowed and the condition is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the **Judicial Magistrate, Tirumangalam** on the 1st working day of every month at 10.30 a.m. until charge sheet is filed.
