This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.P.Jayakumar, Advocate for the petitioners and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

Order

Petition u/s 430 of BNSS praying to suspend the execution of sentence passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madurai in SC.No. 440/2023 dated 13.05.2026 and to release the petitioners/appellants on bail till the disposal of the appeal.

2. Heard. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the trial court has convicted the petitioners/appellants for the offence u/s 325 of IPC and sentenced to undergo S.I. for six months and to pay fine of Rs.500/-, in default, to undergo further S.I. for one month. Fine amount (Rs.500/- each) was paid. The learned counsel for the petitioners further submitted that the trial court has suspended the sentence for one month from the date of judgment and directed the petitioners to prefer an appeal within the time. Hence prayed for suspension of sentence and bail.

3. Perused the petition and judgment. The trial court has convicted the petitioners for the offence stated above. Fine amount was paid by the petitioners and the Receipt is enclosed. The learned counsel for the petitioners represented that sentence has been suspended by the trial court and the appeal has been taken on file. Evidence has to be appreciated for adjudication in the appeal. Considering the

facts and circumstances of the case, this Court inclined to suspend the sentence and enlarge the petitioners on bail and the sentence of imprisonment imposed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madurai in SC.No. 440/2023 dated 13.05.2026 is suspended till the disposal of the appeal in C.A.No.109/2026 on the following conditions:-

1. The petitioners shall execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madurai.

2. The petitioners/accused shall appear before the V Additional District and Sessions Judge, Madurai on 06.07.2026 for further proceedings.
