This petition coming on 03.07.2026 for hearing in the presence of Advocate Tmt.M.Ramar, for the petitioner and Thiru.Balakrishnan Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing the arguments of both side and upon perusing the case records, this court passed the following

ORDER

1. This application has been filed by the petitioner/accused No.2 u/s 483 of BNSS to enlarge the petitioner/accused on bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been remanded to judicial custody on execution of NBW on 12.06.2026 and has been in judicial custody for past 21 days. He would abide by conditions imposed by this court, If he is released on bail.

3. Per contra, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor would object the petition stating that if the petitioner he will not appear for the hearing of the case on the same would hamper the trial. Hence the respondent prayed for dismissal of the petition.

4. To decide this case this court has to considered whether the petitioner could be released on bail at this stage of the case.

5. The accused has been for the offences under section 392 r/w 397 IPC Admittedly the petitioner has failed to appear for hearing of the case and on execution of NBW only his presence has been secured. Further the Accused No. 1 and 3 have still evaded the process of Law and the NBW issued against them still pending for execution. Hence, on considering the nature of case and dilatory tactics played by the accused persons this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
