This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.P.Velmurugan, Advocate for the petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

Order

1. Petition for amendment.
2. Heard both sides.
3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this court as per order in Cr.M.P.No.2510/2026 dated 04.06.2026. The FIR was registered for the offences u/s 296(b), 115(2), 118(1) & 351(3) of BNS and 4 of TNPWH Act. But the section of offences are wrongly mentioned in the petition and the bail order as 296(b), 115(2) & 351(3) of BNS and 4 of TNPWH Act. Hence, the bail order has to be amended accordingly. The learned Public Prosecutor has not raised any serious objections and left the matter to the discretion of the court. Considering the above said facts, this court is inclined to allow the petition and it is ordered to correct the section of offences as 296(b), 115(2), 118(1) & 351(3) of BNS and 4 of TNPWH Act wherever it occurs in the order passed in Cr.M.P.No.2510/2026 dated 04.06.2026.

In the result, the petition is allowed.
