This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.A.Alaguramji, Advocate for the petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

Order

1. Petition to relax the Condition.
2. The offences alleged are u/s 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 351(3) of BNS and 4 of TNPWH Act @ 103(1) of BNS
3. Heard both sides.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was granted bail by this court as per order in Crl.M.P.No.798/2026 dated 26.02.2026 on conditions to appear and sign before the Inspector of Police, respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner observed the condition for 43 days and thereafter, the said condition was modified as per order in Cr.M.P.No.1584/2026 dated 21.04.2026 directing the petitioner to appear and sign before the Inspector of police, respondent police station weekly once i.e. on every Monday at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner is regularly complying with the modified condition for the past 10 weeks. The petitioner is the only earning member in his family and he finds it difficult to comply with the condition. Investigation is almost completed. Hence, it is prayed to relax the condition. The learned Public Prosecutor has not denied the number of days of compliance of condition by the petitioner and further stated that charge sheet is not yet filed and

objected to relax the condition. Considering the above said facts, the number of days of compliance of condition by the petitioner and also the non-filing of charge sheet and this case being a murder case, this court is not inclined to relax the condition, but modified the condition.

In the result, the petition is partly allowed and the condition is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Inspector of police, respondent police station **on the 1st working day of every English Calendar month at 10.00 a.m. until charge sheet is filed.**
