This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.P.Velmurugan, Advocate for the petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

Order

1. Petition filed for extension of time for surrender and execute the bail bond.
2. Heard both sides.
3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner as per order in Cr.M.P.No.2510/2026 dated 04.06.2026 with direction to surrender before the concerned Court within 15 days from the date of order without fail. The section of offences are wrongly mentioned in the bail petition and the bail order and hence, the petitioner filed a petition for amendment, which is pending before this court in Cr.M.P.No.3045/2026. Therefore, the petitioner could not furnish sureties before the concerned court within the time stipulated by this court. Hence, the present petition for extension of time. The learned Public Prosecutor has not raised any serious objections and left the matter to the discretion of the court.
4. Rival contentions are taken into consideration. This court granted anticipatory bail to the petitioner as per order dated 04.06.2026.. The petitioner should have furnished sureties on or before 19.06.2026. The petitioner filed the present petition on 29.06.2026 seeking extension of time to furnish sureties, stating

that the petition for amendment of section of offences is pending enquiry. Considering the reasons assigned by the petitioner and in the interest of justice, this petition is allowed with condition that the petitioner shall surrender and execute the bail bond before the concerned court **on or before 10.07.2026** and other conditions remain as such. No further application seeking extension of time will be entertained.

In the result, the petition is allowed.
