This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.S.Sathish, Advocate for the petitioner and this court passed the following:

Order

1. Petition filed for extension of time for depositing 20% of the compensation amount.

2. Heard both sides.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that this is the 3rd petition seeking extension of time. The trial court has convicted the petitioner/appellant u/s 138 of N.I. Act and sentenced to undergo S.I. for one year and also directed to pay a compensation of Rs.7,02,000/- to the complainant within 2 months, with interest at 9% p.a. from the date of cheque till the date of Judgment i/d to undergo S.I. for 6 months as per Order in STC.No.23/2022 dated 27.02.2026. The petitioner has preferred appeal against the above said Order in C.A.No.85/2026 and filed petition in Cr.M.P.No.1760/2026 to suspend the sentence and bail. This court has suspended the sentence till the disposal of the appeal as per order in Cr.M.P.No.1760/2026 dated 29.04.2026 with conditions to deposit 20% of the compensation amount before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Usilampatti within a month and other conditions. The Vacation Sessions Court, Madurai has granted further time of 3 weeks as per order in Cr.M.P.No.379/2026 dated 29.05.2026 and this court granted further time upto 07.07.2026 to deposit the amount. Due to ill health, the petitioner

was hospitalized and thereby, he could not mobilize the amount within the time extended by this court and prayed to grant further time to deposit the amount and produced the copy of Medical Certificate of the petitioner for perusal.

4. This is the 3rd petition seeking extension of time to deposit the 20% compensation amount. In the earlier order in Cr.M.P.No.2940/2026 dated 25.06.2026 itself, it is made clear that no further application seeking extension of time will be entertained. In spite of that the petitioner has not deposited the amount. There is no valid ground to allow the petition. Therefore, I am not inclined to allow the petition.

In the result, the petition is dismissed.
