This bail petition is coming before me on 06.06.2026 in the presence of Advocate Tmt.Vasuki, for the petitioner and Learned A.P.P. for the Respondent, After careful perusal of records and the Argument put forth by the petitioner this Court passed the following...

ORDER

Heard both the sides and Records were perused.

The counsel for the petitioner/accused argued that the petitioner has not been any alleged offence, he has been in judicial custody from 04.06.2026, the alleged injured in this case already discharged from the hospital and prayed for bail.

The prosecution in their reply has stated that this case is in preliminary stage of investigation, the injured in this case has already been discharged from the hospital and objected to granting bail to the petitioner.

On considering the submission made by the petitioner counsel and reply received by the concern police the injured in this case already been discharged from the hospital, already co-accused A1 released on bail by this court in Cr.M.P.No.1741/2026, dated: 27.04.2026 and this court considered view that by this time investigation would have been completed there is no further investigation in this case. Considering the above and also other circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to grant bail to the accused with certain conditions. Accordingly, this bail petition is allowed on following conditions.

1) The accused shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for a like sum each.

2) The accused shall appear and sign before the respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 A.M., until further orders.

3) The accused shall co-operate for the investigation agency as and when required by the respondent police.

4) The petitioner accused shall not commit any kind of similar offence in future.
