ORDER

The Investigation Officer has submitted a Final Report under section 173(2) Cr.P.C in Cr.No.342/2024, stating that the missing Two-wheeler was not able to found by the Tirumangalam town P.S. . Hence, the case is Referred as Un-Detected. 2. The case was originally registered under section 303(2) BNS based on the complaint of the informant dated 27.08.2024. Investigation included examining the scene of crime, recording witness statements. 3. Notice was issued to the complainant / informant under the principal laid down in Bhagwant Singh Vs. Commissioner of Police [(1985)2 SCC 5371] ensuring they had an opportunity to oppose the closure. Vide D.No.280/2026, dated:10.02.2026. Notice was served. The complainant present and did not express objection to the closure. 4. The court has perused the police file and final report. Upon consideration, there appears to be no ground to disagree with the police conclusion. There is no material requiring further investigation at this stage. Direction: 5. Accordingly, the Final Report is accepted, and the case is closed as Un-Detected.
