This petition coming on 03.07.2026 for final hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.S.Surendar, learned counsel for Petitioner and the Learned APP for the Respondent/Complainant and upon perusal of the records, this court delivers the following.

ORDER

1. The petitioner filed the petition to modify the 1st condition imposed by this court in Cr.M.P.No.335/2026 vide dated 30.03.2026.
2. The petitioner has sated that during the enquiry in the regional passport office, Madurai stated that “*there is any criminal case pending against the applicant, we only reissue/renew his/her passport for the period of one year, until any*

applicant will get the no objection order for reissue/renew his passport with mentioned specific period (2 or 3 or 5 years) from the concern court, if any applicant get the such orders, we will ready to reissue/renew his passport such year mentioned in the order of the concern court.” Through this court the petitioner in CrI.M.P.No.335/2026, dated 30.03.2026 has obtained NOC for issuance/renewal of his passport. Subsequently based on the enquiry with the passport authorities filing this petition requesting for issuance of no objection certificate for issuance of reissue/renewal of his passport No.N1986138 for the period of three years. If this petition not allowed he would be put into peril and irreparable loss.

3. This court heard the rival submission and perused the material records considering the reason stated by the petitioner side, in the interest of justice this petition is allowed with the modification in the order passed by this court in CrI.M.P.No.335/2026, dated 30.03.2026 that “ there is no bar to the petitioner to renew his passport and this order shall be considered as a NOC for a period of 2 years from the date of the above order.” and other conditions remain unchanged.
4. This petition is disposed accordingly.
