Present: None for the complainant.

PF not filed.

Previous order dated 27.01.2026 not complied with.

Upon perusing the file, it is noted that this is the 5th consecutive date of hearing when none has appeared on behalf of complainant and also steps have not been taken for issuance of the process on behalf of the complainant which has been recorded in several previous orders.

Since, this is a complaint case, this is the duty of the complainant to pursue the matter diligently and as per law. The well known legal maxim goes “*vigilantibus non dormientibus subserviunt*” thereby meaning that “*The laws serve those who are vigilant, not those who are sleeping*”. It seems that complainant is not interested in pursuing the present matter. Accordingly, the present matter stands dismissed due to non-appearance and non-prosecution by the complainant.
