This petition came up before me for final hearing on this day in the presence of Tr.P.Naveenkumar,B.A., B.L., Advocate for the petitioner and the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, this court delivers the following:

**ORDER**

1. This petition has been filed under section 480 BNSS to enlarge the petitioner on bail, who was remanded to Judicial Custody through NBW on 25/06/2026 for offences alleged under section 392 of IPC.

2. The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner/accused was remanded to Judicial Custody through NBW on 25/09/2025. The petitioner is ready

and willing to abide by the condition, if any imposed by this court. Hence prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

3. The concerned police in their reply stated that the accused will abscond and will not appear before this court, if he is released on bail.

4. In this case, NBW is pending against the accused from 25.09.2025. This is a case of year 2013. NBW is pending against the accused for a long time. No progress was achieved in this case, due to the absconding of the accused. The accused may abscond again, if bail is granted.

5. Considering the above said facts and circumstances of the case, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

**In fine the petition is dismissed.**
