1. Heard both sides' counsel. Records perused. petition filed to examine the Village Administrative Officer as witness on the side of the petitioner / plaintiff as the property was the panjami land, was allotted only to the Adhithravidar Community hence the respondent cannot claim title over the petition mentioned property.

2. On the other hand, the respondent / defendant filed counter contending that the suit filed only for permanent injunction and not for declaration. There is no mention about any document by which the Village Administrative Officer of Thandalai is going to be examined. This petition filed only to delay the suit proceedings. Hence this petition is liable to be dismissed.

3. Both sides did not file any documents.

4. Even though the petitioner did not file any documents to prove his case, this court is of the view that examining the VAO, Thandalai will not cause any irreparable loss to the respondent. Further examining the VAO, Thandalai will aid this court in deciding the main suit. Hence, this court is inclined to allow this petition under order 16 rule 6 to present the petition to summon the VAO, Thandalai to produce the revenue documents regarding the suit property in his possession.

5. **In the result**, this petition is allowed. No costs.
