

CHI-541 State Vs. Devender Singh etc.

In the wake of the pandemic disease of Coronavirus (Covid-19), certain precautionary measures are been taken in compliance of the instructions and advisories issued by the Government and the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana. As a measure to combat the spreading of Covid-19, the Hon'ble High Court has issued instructions to reduce foot fall by only taking up bail, stay and urgent matters. Therefore, the ordinary matters are to be adjourned without pressing upon the attendance of the parties, if otherwise not required. No adverse order is to be passed due to non-appearance. The litigants and the advocates are refraining from appearing in person.

In compliance of the orders/instructions of the Hon'ble High Court and conveyed and implemented by the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Jind vide Endst. No. 07-15 dated 01.01.2021, the respective Courts which are not on duty are directed to adjourn all the matters to appropriate dates and only the Courts on duty shall deal with cases fixed during tenure of their duty period, file is hereby taken up. As a measure to combat the spreading of Covid-19, the accused is/are also not been produced by the jail authorities. Therefore, he/they be called through production warrant for 18.01.2021. The case is hereby adjourned to 18.01.2021 for the purpose already fixed. All concerned be informed accordingly.
