This petition came up today for the hearing in the presence of Thiru. R. Radhakrishnan, Advocate for the Petitioner and Tmt. A. Aruna on behalf of the Public Prosecutor for the State and after careful consideration of the materials available on record and the submissions made on behalf of the parties, this court passed the following:

ORDER

1. This is a petition filed U/s. 482 of BNSS, 2023.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner/Accused submitted that the respondent police has registered a case against the petitioner for the offences U/s. 296(b), 126(2), 118(1), 351(3) of BNS. The alleged occurrence is said to have taken place on 08.02.2026. The petitioner is innocent and he did not commit any offences as alleged by the prosecution. The co-accused/ A1, A3 already enlarged on bail. Injured person discharged from the hospital. The *defacto complainant* has given false complaint against the petitioner. The petitioner apprehend arrest at the hands of police and he is ready to abide by any conditions that would be imposed by this court and prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The Learned Public Prosecutor argued that on 08.02.2026 at 10.00 PM the petitioner and the co-accused persons waylaid the bus which is parked in front of the

hotels. When it was questioned by the defacto complainant the accused persons made unnecessary quarrel and scolded him in filthy language, assaulted him using iron rod over his face and various places of the body and criminally intimidated him before leaving the place. Hence, the case. Injured person still taking treatment as in patient. Investigation is pending. He made objections to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. This court carefully considered the submission made by either side. One Citrarasan, S/o. Selvam cited as A2 in a case registered in Cr.No.63/2026 has filed this application for pre arrest bail. In his application he has claimed on his own that he is A3 in a case. The records would go to show that he is A2. Further, A1 and A3 already remanded to judicial custody, A2 and A4 are yet to be secured by the police. The investigation is in the preliminary stage. The complaint was obtained from the defacto complainant, when he was undergoing treatment as in patient in the Government Hospital, Sirkali. The defacto complainant sustained head injuries and still undergoing treatment. Therefore, this petition deserves dismissal.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
