u/s.87 r/w 95 rule schedule 24 clause 10(y). In default 3 weeks Simple Imprisonment and Rs.2000/- each u/s. 41 r/w 61(D) r/w 92 Factories Act section 88 rule 96 (1) (2) r/w 92 Factories Act. In default 3 weeks Simple Imprisonment each. Total fine Rs.29,000/-.
