The Petitioner/Accused filed this petition U/s. 480 BNSS for the offences U/s. 316 (2), 318(4) of BNS 2023 in Palaiyur Police Station, Cr. No. 102/2026.

Learned counsel for the petitioner / Accused submit:

1. The petitioner/Accused has been judicial custody from 10.03.2026
2. The Petitioner/Accused is innocent, the police has falsely implicated the accused name in this case.
3. The accused is the law abiding citizen and he will not abscond anywhere.
4. Due to the Judicial Custody of the accused, the family of the accused is suffering in severe.
5. He has not committed any offence. Hence, the petitioner prayed bail.

The Respondent Police filed the reply and submit:

If the accused in this case is released on bail, he will be abscond, he will commit the same nature of offence, he will not appear before this court at the time of trial and he will tamper the prosecution witness. Hence, the respondent strongly object for granting bail to the accused.

On perusal of records and submission made by both side, The accused was charged for the alleged offence U/s. 316 (2), 318(4) of BNS 2023 in Palaiyur Police Station in Cr. No. 102/2026. The petitioner is in Judicial Custody for the past 7 days. The accusation is against petitioner/Accused are well founded. The investigation is also pending. Considering all the facts and circumstance of the nature of offence, period of incarceration and the severity of the offence this court is declined to enlarge the petitioner/ Accused on bail.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
