The petition is coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Advocate Mr. A. Ayyappan, for the petitioners / Accused and Assistant Public Prosecutor for Respondent Police, after hearing their submission, this court passed the following

The Petitioners / Accused filed this petition u/s 480 BNSS for the offences U/S.296(b),118(1),351(3) BNS in Mayiladuthurai Police Station, Crime No. 0272 / 2026.

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners / Accused submit:

The petitioners/Accused have been in judicial custody from 23.03.2026. The Petitioners/Accused are innocent, the police has falsely implicated the accused name in this case. The accused are the law abiding citizen and they will not abscond anywhere. The accused are the bread winner of the family. Due to the Judicial Custody of the accused, the family of the accused are suffering in severe economical condition. Hence, the petitioners prayed bail.

2. The Respondent Police filed the reply and submit:

Investigation is pending. If the accused released on bail, The will committing same offence again. If they released on bail, they will tamper the prosecution witness and will be involved in the same offence again. Injured discharged from hospital. Hence, the respondent strongly object for granting bail to the accused.

On perusal of records and submission made by both side, the accused are in judicial custody past 10 days. Considering all the facts and circumstance of the nature of offence, period of incarceration, Injured discharged from hospital, by this time investigation could have been over, hence no question of tampering, this court is inclined enlarge bail to the petitioners with following conditions:

1. The Accused/Petitioners shall Execute a bond worth of sum of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties like sum each.
2. The Accused/Petitioners shall appeared before the respondent Police Station every day at about 10.30 a.m. and sign for 15 days.
3. The Accused/Petitioners should not tamper the prosecution evidence in the investigation or Trial.
4. The Accused/Petitioners must co-operate to the prosecution for investigation or Trial.
5. The Accused/Petitioners should appear to court on summon without fail.
6. If the accused violated any condition which was imposed by this court, the prosecution will take appropriate action accordance with law.
