ORDER

The charge sheet filed by the Inspector of Police CBCID, Nagapattinam against the accused Tmt. Madurai Renuga Devi, accused C.H. Yadhaya in Cr. No.01/2010 u/s 420 IPC @ 420 IPC, 120(b) r/w 34 IPC before Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nagapattinam. On the point of jurisdiction, this case transferred to this court. 1st accused Renuga Devi died on 07.10.2018 and hence charge abated against A1 on 26.08.2022. Further this court took steps for Surety Action (Old CrI.M.P. No.22/2018) CrI.M.P. No.2363/2025 and one surety Dhanaya died and other surety Sudhakar present and paid the fine of Rs.5,000/-. After completion of Surety Action, this court took steps u/s 84 of BNSS Act and issued a written proclamation in the place of the accused where he ordinarily resides. Hence it is proved, that the accused presence has been absconded and there is no immediate prospect of arrest by the police and hence the accused is declared as proclaimed offender. Hence the above case is shifted to the register of long pending cases.
