Clarifications are sought from SHO.

The FIR was registered in the present case on 04.10.2024 on the complaint given to the police on 30.11.2022 alleging the detection of theft of electricity during the inspection carried out on 03.11.2022.

It is stated by Ld. Counsel for complainant that original documents along with CD and photographs have been given to police along with complaint.

The SHO PS Wazirabad is having no explanation to the loss of original documents filed with the complaint by the complainant company except that complaint with the documents is not traceable. He is also not able to explain why this fact has not been mentioned in the final report.

The chargesheet is being filed for the offence punishable under Section 135/150 Indian Electricity Act. The name of the Act is not correctly mentioned. Section 150 of Electricity Act

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pertains to abetment of offence and there is no report by whom the offence is abetted.

Ld. Counsel for complainant seeks adjournment stating that she will file an application as the investigations have not been conducted properly.

The complainant may take remedy available to it as per law and matter is adjourned for **01.08.2026** for consideration for declining the cognizance/stopping the proceedings in the matter.
