

MODERN AGENCIES VS S.K. FOOD

Present: Sh. Kewal Krishan Gupta Advocate for the complainant.

Accused has not come present. Statutory period of 30 days has already been expired as proclamation has already been effected. So, the **accused Mr. Savrat Kumar, proprietor of M/s S.K. Food, Jammu Market, Main Bazar Tripuri, Near Water Tank, Patiala** is ordered to be declared proclaimed person- absconder with regard to present complaint.

Since accused has been declared as proclaimed person, as such proceedings U-s 83 Cr.P.C. be initiated against the accused. I have asked the ld. counsel for complainant to provide list of property of accused so that it can be attached, to which he orally submitted that at present he has no knowledge about the list of property of the accused. It is further orally submitted at bar that complainant is not intending to lead evidence U-s 299 Cr.P.C. Still in the interest of justice, matter can be taken up again if complainant or his counsel provides the list of property for the purpose of attachment of accused-proclaimed person. If provided, file is to be taken up again. In the meanwhile file is ordered to be consigned to the record room with the directions to revive it back as and when accused-proclaimed person is arrested, appear or surrender before the court.
