ORDER.

Bikramjit Singh (applicant/accused), has filed instant
application under **Section 482 of B.N.S.S.** for grant of pre-arrest bail,

on the ground that he is innocent, has been falsely implicated in this case with huge undue and unexplained delay of about 8 to 9 years. The allegations leveled in the FIR are false and baseless and not even a single penny has been transferred in the account of the applicant and the alleged transactions pertaining to year 2017 is dealing between the father of the applicant and the complainant and applicant has no knowledge about the same. Rather, an amount of Rs.2000/- has been transferred from the account of the applicant to the account of complainant on 29.04.2021 which was monetary help extended by the applicant to the complainant. The applicant has never cheated the complainant nor made any claim to get job and the allegations have been leveled by complainant for the first time after death of father of the applicant. Moreover, it is highly improbable that the talk regarding securing the job took place in the year 2017 and the alleged payments made in account of Harsharanjit Singh and one Jasbir Singh in the year 2017 but the complainant never made any such complaint earlier. The averments in the inquiry are not even mentioned in the application moved by the complainant nor there is any evidence with regard to payment of Rs.3 lacs and the complainant has created witness of choice just to substantiate his claim. The entire case is hinges upon

documentary evidence. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant/accused. Now, the police officials of **Police Station Talwandi Bhai, Ferozepur**, are conducting raids in the house of the accused-applicant. He is ready to join the investigation, if in that event IO/SHO/arresting officer be directed that on doing so, he be released on bail. (*Application is duly supported with affidavit*).

2. Upon notice, ***Sh.Amit Goklaney, learned Additional Public Prosecutor***, for the state duly assisted by Sh.Navdeep Sandhu,Adv.counsel for complainant appeared. No reply to the application has been filed but hotly contested the same.

3. **Police record** requisitioned, received and perused.

4. **Raj Kumar (complainant)** moved application before Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, on the allegations that, in the year 2020, his father died. However, before death of his father, he (complainant) and Bikramjit Singh both were close friends. Father of Bikramjit Singh was already posted as Clerk in the office of Deputy Commissioner. Bikramjit Singh allured him (complainant) to get him recruited in the said Department and demanded Rs.3 lacs. On 27.04.2017, Bikramjit Singh alongwith his father visited their house and under said allurement, obtained Rs.40,000/-in cash whereas, the

remaining amount of Rs. 3 lacs was transferred in the bank accounts of Kanwar Arvinder Singh bearing A/c No.33708292315 State Bank of India; Bank A/c No.50100172281400 of Harsharanjit Singh and one another A/c No.50100074250971 of Jasbir Singh. Further, an amount of Rs.15000/-was transferred in bank A/c No.2094108063 of Komal (sister of Bikramjit). However, lateron, the accused failed to get him recruited, thus committed the offence of cheating. Allegations leveled by complainant were inquired by Deputy Superintendent of Police(SD) Ferozepur and after inquiry, instant case was got registered.

5. After having considering rival submissions put forth by counsel for both the parties and, perusal of police record reveals that, there is enough space for investigation from the point of view of the applicant/accused. Moreover, after applicant/accused join the investigation, clouds of dust surrounding the prosecution case, would become clear and, it would lead the case to logical conclusion and further, in order to conduct effective investigation, ***Bikramjit Singh (applicant/accused)*** is **allowed** to join investigation **within four days**, and on his doing so, he shall be released on **interim anticipatory bail** to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer/SHO concerned, subject to the compliance of the following conditions:-

1. That the applicant shall join the investigation as and when required by the police.
2. That the applicant shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any Police Officer.
3. That the applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the court.

Copy of this order be sent to the concerned quarters for compliance. However, these observation of mine shall have no effect on the merits of the case.

Record be produced on **30.06.2026**.
