Judgement

1. Complainant absent. Accused present. This case is pending for complainant side evidence since 05.05.2026. The complainant has been very irregular in attending the hearings and he remains absent for more than 1 year. Previously as the accused was residing in abroad, warrant was pending against him for more than a decade and it was recently recalled on 21.04.2026. After completion of initial formalities, this court had posted the case for complainant side evidence. But, the complainant chose not to turn up before this court even after sending of final notice calling for his appearance through a registered post. On the other hand since cancellation of warrant the accused has been promptly appearing for the court hearings.

2. Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to exercise its power U/s.256 of CrPc. Accordingly, this complaint is dismissed for non-appearance of the complainant and the accused is acquitted from the charge U/s.138 of NI Act. No property involved in this case.
