ORDER

1. This application u/s.12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act has been filed by the aggrieved petitioner. The respondents are her husband, mother-in-law, sister-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law's husband. The

petitioner has sought various reliefs such as protection order, residence order, monetary relief and compensation. R1-R4 were set exparte and the petitioner had not pressed her claim in respect of R5. This case is pending for petitioner side exparte evidence since 14.11.2025. In spite of grant of several opportunities for the past 4 months, the petitioner did not come forward to adduce any evidence on her side. Lastly she was present on 27.10.2025 and thereafter she did not turn up before this court. Today as well the petitioner has not turned up before this court and failed to contest this case. There was also no representation for her.

2. Considering the said facts and circumstances, non appearance of the petitioner, failure on her part to contest this case, this Court deems it fit to dismiss the application on hand for default of the petitioner with a cost of Rs.2000/- payable to the District Mediation Centre, Mayiladuthurai for wasting the precious time of this Court.
