**Fresh claim petition U/S 166 of M.V. Act received by way of assignment.
It be checked & registered.**

Present:- Sh. Deepak Kumar, Ld. counsel for the petitioner.

In compliance of Rule 8 (2) (b) of Delhi MACT Rules, 2008 evidence by way of affidavit of petitioner no.1 along with list of witnesses has been filed.

Perusal of record reveals that FIR was lodged by complainant Mohd. Azim.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant of FIR Mohd. Azim was not in contact with the petitioner, rather petitioner is in contact with mother of deceased who has been impleaded as respondent no.5.

With respect to eye witness, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the details of eye witness would be given after filing of charge-sheet and undertakes that no witness other than mentioned in the charge-sheet would be examined in support of claim petition.

Subject to above condition, issue notice of the claim petition to all the respondents on filing of PF through all modes.

The petitioner/claimant is directed to open saving bank account in any nationalized bank near the place of his/her residence if already not opened.

The concerned Bank Manager of the Bank, where the petitioner already has a bank account or a new bank account is opened, is directed as follows:

(i). No Cheque Book and ATM/Debit Card be issued to the petitioner without permission of the Court/MACT Tribunal. However, in case the

ATM/Debit Card and/or Cheque Book have already been issued, bank shall cancel the same before the disbursement of the amount.

(ii). The Bank shall not permit any joint name(s) to be added in the savings bank account or fixed deposit accounts of the petitioner. However, money may be released by means of a withdrawal slip.

(iii) The Bank Manager of petitioner's bank is also directed to make endorsement regarding compliance of aforesaid directions on the passbook.

After the Bank Manager makes the endorsement regarding compliance of the aforesaid directions on the passbook of the petitioner, the petitioner shall produce the original passbook having the said endorsements as well as Aadhaar Card and PAN Card before the Tribunal on the next date of hearing or in any case before hearing the final arguments.

If the petitioner fails to comply with the said direction, the disbursement of the award amount (if the award is passed) shall be made subject to the following conditions:

The petitioner shall have to open a MACT compliance Bank account in the UCO Bank, Karkardooma, subject to aforesaid terms and conditions and the petitioner shall also furnish the details of the branch of UCO bank near the place of petitioner's residence to which the bank account of the petitioner in the UCO bank, Karkardooma branch may be transferred subject to all hereinabove conditions.
