

Case called before Lokadalath.

Both the parties present. Their respective advocates are also present. D3 has appeared before the court through video conference.

Since, D4 is minor an application was filed by the D3 and D4 u/O.32 Rule 9 of the CPC in order to permit them to compromise the matter on their behalf. In the application it was contended that since the compromise is for the benefit of the minor defendant and no harm will be caused to the minor defendant if the compromised is allowed.

Heard.

Satisfied.

Hence, the application is allowed.

Further advocate for D3 and D4 also filed certificate stating that the compromise is for the benefit of the minor D4.

Heard. Perused. Satisfied.

The same is allowed.

Received the mediation report upon which the parties have settled the matter.

As per the terms of the agreement arrived between the parties the plaintiff, the D3 and D4 are entitled for 1/3rd share in the death benefits of deceased Jagadish.S which are given by the D1 with respect to death relief fund, provident fund, gratuity, group insurance savings, group savings linked insurance and balance of salary.

If the D3 remarry in future she is responsible to take care of the welfare of the D4 such as education, medical, marriage, etc. Since no relief is claimed against D1 and D2, however, as per the terms of the

agreement they are also bound by this agreement.

The terms of the agreement are read over to the parties.

They admit the settlement arrived in between them is fair, reasonable, voluntary and without force.

In view of the submissions of the parties the memorandum of agreement is hereby allowed and the suit of the plaintiff is decreed in terms of the compromise petition.

Accordingly, the suit of the plaintiff is decreed in the terms of the compromise petition.

Office is directed to draw decree in the terms of the compromise petition.

Office is also directed to return the original documents produced by the plaintiff after obtaining the copies of the same in favor of the plaintiff after proper identification.
