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SUIT CLAIM :- Suit was filed on **22/03/2024** by the
plaintiff and prays to :

- A) Declaration that plaintiff is entitle for 1/3rd
share in the Death benefits of Jagadish S who is
employee in 1st defendant ID no.4435 as
Inspector-S.7

- B) Direct the 1st defendant to disburse 1/3rd share in death benefits to the plaintiff.
- C) Permanent injunction restraining the 1st defendant not to disburse entire death benefits of Jagadish. S Employee ID No.4435 to 3rd defendant till the disposal of this suit.

This suit coming on this day for final disposal before **Smt. PRASHANTHI. G, IX Additional City Civil and Sessions Judge, Bangalore City**, in the presence of Sri. Anil Shekar K.S - Advocate for plaintiff and of Sri. K.S.Bheemaiah - Advocate for defendant Nos.1 & 2, Sri. Mahabaleshwara G.C - Advocate for Defendant No.3 & 4

It is ordered and decreed that the suit of the plaintiff is decreed in terms of the compromise petition vide copy of compromise petition/ memorandum of agreement is enclosed herewith.

As per the terms of the agreement arrived between the parties the plaintiff, the D3 and D4 are entitled for 1/3rd share in the death benefits of deceased Jagadish. S which are given by the D1 with

respect to death relief fund, provident fund, gratuity, group insurance savings, group savings linked insurance and balance of salary.

If the D3 remarry in future, she is responsible to take care of the welfare of the D4 such as education, medical, marriage etc., Since no relief is claimed against D1 and D2, however, as per the terms of the agreement they are also bound by this agreement.

And that a sum of NIL be paid to the plaintiff by the defendants on account of the costs of the suit.
