This petition is coming before me for final final hearing today in the presence of Thiru.K.M.Balaji, learned counsel for the Petitioner/Accused No.1 and the respondent police and after hearing both sides this court passes the following;



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ORDER

This petition is filed by the Petitioner/Accused no.1 for relaxation of condition already imposed on the Petitioner/Accused No.1 in Crl.M.P.No.151/2026 on 16.02.2026.

2. The respondent Police registered a case against the petitioner and others for the offences U/s.103 of BNS Act.

3. The Petitioner/Accused no.1 was ordered to be released on bail by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.924/2025 dated 02.12.2025 with condition to sign before the C1 Katoor Police Station, Coimbatore daily at 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. until further orders and then it was modified in Crl.M.P.No.1078/2025 on 19.12.2025 and the petitioner was ordered to appear and sign before the C1 Katoor Police Station, Coimbatore weekly twice on every Wednesday and Sunday at 9.00 a.m. and then it was modified in Crl.M.P.No.75/2026 on 30.01.2026 and the petitioner was ordered to appear and sign before the Erode Town Police Station, Erode District weekly twice on every Wednesday and Sunday at 9.00 a.m until further orders and then it was modified in Crl.M.P.No.151/2026 on 16.02.2026 and the petitioner was ordered to appear and sign before the



Erode Town Police Station, Erode District monthly once on 1st working day of every calendar month at 10.30 a.m until further orders.

Now, the Petitioner/Accused No.1 has come before this court for relaxation of condition stating that, the petitioner has complied the condition imposed against him for the past 4 months and accordingly he prays to relax the condition.

4. The respondent police submitted their objections stating that the Petitioner/Accused No.1 has been complying the condition from 02.03.2026, 01.04.2026, 01.05.2026 and 01.07.2026 and he has not signed in June month and that the petitioner will indulge in the similar type of offence and as such they have serious objections to relax the condition imposed against the petitioner.

5. Heard. The Petitioner/ Accused No.1 is admittedly adhering to the condition imposed by this court from 02.03.2026, 01.04.2026, 01.05.2026 and 01.07.2026 and the police filed final report and the case numbered in S.C.No.21/2026. Hence this court is inclined to totally relax the condition.



In the result, this petition is allowed and the condition already imposed on the Petitioner/ Accused no.1 by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.151/2026 on 16.02.2026 is relaxed with a direction to appear before this court for the hearings without fail.
