ORDER

The Petitioner/Accused filed a bail application Under Section 480 of B.N.S.S for the alleged offence U/s.331(3), 305(a) of BNS Act to enlarge him on bail.

2. The learned counsel for the Petitioner/Accused would submit that the Petitioner/Accused was arrested in a case registered in Kolacombai Police Station in Crime No.47/2026, U/s.331(3), 305(a) of BNS. The Petitioner/Accused is in judicial custody from 22.05.2026 to till date. Further the Petitioner/Accused is innocent and he did not involve in the alleged offence. The Petitioner/Accused will neither abscond not tamper with the prosecution witness and he is ready to give sufficient sureties in the event of releasing him on bail. **Therefore, this bail petition may be allowed.**

3. On the side of the respondent, they objected that the investigation is not yet completed and that he committed the theft of Rs.3,000/- and house Hundi (Undiyal) and

also one more previous case is pending against him, if the accused is released on bail, he may be threatening the witness and he may indulged the same offence.

4. Both side heard and records perused. On perusal of records, it is found that the Petitioner / Accused was remanded to judicial custody on 22.05.2026 and for past 43 days he is under judicial custody. Considering the facts and circumstances and the remand period, and in the interest of justice, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with the following conditions:-

Conditions :-

1. The Petitioner/Accused shall execute a bond each for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for like sum each.
2. Direct the petitioner/accused to appear and sign before Respondent Police Station on every Friday at 10.00 A.M. until 31.07.2026.
