

SURINDER SINGH Vs KOTAK MAHINDRA BANK

Present: Appellant with counsel Shri Naresh Chander, Advocate.

Appellant has come present today.

Along with the appeal application for suspension of sentence (as detailed in the application) has also been received.

During arguments, learned counsel for appellant reiterated the facts as contained in the application and argued that since the disposal of appeal may take time, the judgment and order of sentence as well as compensation awarded by learned JMIC, may be stayed, till then.

Considering the fact that the appellant-accused was on bail, during the pendency of the trial and the fact that the appeal is not likely to be heard in the near future, substantive sentence imposed upon the appellant, by the Learned Trial Court is suspended till the pendency of the present appeal, on his furnishing requisite bail/surety bonds in the sum of Rs.1 Lac with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of trial/Illaq/Duty Magistrate within 15 working days from today.

As mentioned supra, the appellant has also prayed for suspension of order of compensation awarded by learned JMIC, Chandigarh. In the given circumstances, the payment of compensation awarded by the trial Court under Section 357(2) Cr.P.C is also stayed.

Accordingly, the abovesaid application stands disposed of.

Copy of this order be sent to learned Trial Court.

Learned Trial Court is directed to send the bail/surety bonds in original to this court, on or before the next date of hearing.

Affidavit of compliance be also furnished on the next date of hearing.

Today an application for seeking waiver of depositing the 20% of the compensation amount has also been received.

Let notice of the appeal as well application be issued to the respondent for 03.08.2026.
