AWARD

The dispute between the parties having been referred for determination to the Lok Adalat and the parties having compromised/settled the case/matter, the following award is passed in terms of the settlement: LA-424/25

Injured/Victim has voluntarily compounded the offence punishable U/s of IPC / BNS against the accused. Consequently, the accused is/are acquitted U/s 320(8) Cr.P.C/359 BNSS of the offences punishable U/s 323, 326, 329 of IPC / BNS.

At the intervention of the elders the victims and the accused entered into compromise before the Lok Adalat. The De-facto complainant agreed to compound the offences U/s 323, 326, 329 of IPC / BNS against the accused.

The accused paid an amount of Rs. 10000 to the victim/injured towards compensation.

The averments of the Terms of Compromise memo were read over and explained to both parties in Telugu and admitted by them to be true and correct. Hence, the Terms of compromise memo filed by the both parties are allowed. In view of the allowing of terms of compromise memo filed by both parties, the case filed by the victim has to be settled. In the result, award is passed accordingly in terms of compromise. Enclosed the Terms of compromise filed by the both parties along with the award.
