This application has been filed to receive additional written statement filed by the petitioner/2<sup>nd</sup> defendant.

2. According to the petitioner, the suit was actually decreed exparte and thereafter exparte decree was set aside on the application made by the respondent and now after Pw1 was examined in chief and when the case is posted for cross examination, the petitioner has come forward with this application to receive the additional written statement which is belated one and therefore, the same shall not be accepted.

3. The perusal of additional written statement shows that the petitioner has made a plea regarding the non-joinder of necessary parties and pendency of another suit regarding the suit property and other properties before the same Court and the pleadings in the additional written

statement will not in any way create a new case. Therefore, this Court considers that though this application is made belatedly and the same can be allowed in the interest of justice.
