This petition coming on this day before me for order in the presence of Thiru. A. Pakutharivalan Advocate for the petitioner and the Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides, this Court has delivered the following...

ORDER

This petition has been filed U/s.483 of BNSS for grant of bail to the petitioner for the offences U/S. 24 (1) COTPA Act 2003 and 77 of the Juvenile Justice Act 2015.

2. The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused stated that the dated of Occurrence on 17.02.2026 and the date of FIR was registered on 17.02.2026 and that he was remanded in judicial custody on 17.02.2026 by the Judicial Magistrate No.2, Perambalur and the earlier bail application was dismissed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.222/2026 dated on 03.03.2026 and he is innocent and he has not committed any such offence and he is falsely implicated in this case and he never moved similar bail petition before the Hon'ble High Court at Madras.

3. Reply received. The learned Public Prosecutor has argued that the petitioner is having hans 38 bundles 57 Pocket, weight 570/20 = 11.400krm, Cool Lip 29 pocket weight 29.12.6 = 362gm, Vimal Pakku 50 bundle 1500 pocket weight

1500x205=3.750kgm, V2 Pakku 50 bundle 1500 pocket weight 1500x1=1500krm
Total 17,015kgm worth of Rs.12,814/- and that case property was recovered and
the accused arrested and in judicial custody on 17.02.2026 and in this case, the
property has to be handed over to the Judicial Magistrate No.II and an RP number has
to be obtained and he strongly objected to release the accused on bail..

4. Heard both sides. On perusal of records, this petitioner/accused was
remanded on 17.02.2026 and also considered that hans 38 bundles 57 Pocket, weight
570/20 = 11.400krm, Cool Lip 29 pocket weight 29.12.6 = 362gm, Vimal Pakku 50
bundle 1500 pocket weight 1500x205=3.750kgm, V2 Pakku 50 bundle 1500 pocket
weight 1500x1=1500krm Total 17,015kgm worth of Rs.12,814/- and that case
property was recovered from this petitioner and IO has failed to raise any objection
with regard to their investigation in this case. Considering the period of remand
investigation might be completed and that the earlier bail application was dismissed
by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.222/2026 dated on 03.03.2026. Considering the period
of remand and under such facts and circumstances of the case, to secure the
presence of the accused, with stringent conditions, this Court is inclined to grant bail
to the petitioner on the following conditions:

(a) that the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his execution of a
bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousands only) with two sureties for a like sum to
the satisfaction of Judicial of Magistrate II, Perambalur and one of the surety should
be a blood related person or parents

(b) that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent Police Station, daily
once at 10.00 a.m. for 30 days.

(c) the petitioner should produce proof for their permanent address.

(d) that the petitioner shall not hamper the investigation.

(e) that the petitioner should not leave India without intimation to this
Court.
