This petition coming on this day before me for order in the presence of Thiruvallargal.M.Sathiyaseelan, R.Sakthibalan, S.Sethilvelan Advocates for the petitioner and of the Special Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides, perusing the petition and other relevant records, this Court has delivered the following...

**ORDER**

This petition has been filed by the petitioner to release on bail u/S.294(b), 323, 366, 427, 506(i) of IPC and 5(l), 6, 11(4), 12 of POCSO Act and 4 of TNPHW Act on the file of the respondent.

1. On service of notice through Investigation officer, defacto complainant, who is the mother of the victim present and filed her written objection and she objected to release the accused on bail.

2. The counsel for the petitioner was not appear in the court he was suffered illness and he had attacked by some person one week before and but it is seen this case pending for non appearance before August 2025 and this Honourable court execute NBW was issued on 31.10.2025 and the respondent police execute the NBW warrant dated on 20.11.2025 by this

Hon'ble Court and the earlier bail application was dismissed by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.10/2023 and sufficient sureties will offer for him and he is released he will not evade trail and he will not tamper any witness and no bail application was filed for before the Hon'ble High Court, Chennai.

3. The Special Public Prosecutor submitted IO reply and stating that the accused was remanded on 20.11.2025 and this case was taken on file in Spl.S.C.No. 5/2025 and NBW as issued on 31.10.2025 against the accused and who had failed to appear in court proceedings and the order was executed on 20.11.2025 and if he released in the bail he may abscond again and strongly objected.

4. Both sides heard. Records perused. This case is involved in Cr.No.10/2023 of Perambalur All Women Police Station against this accused under Sections 294(b), 323, 366, 427, 506(i) of IPC and 5(1), 6, 11(4), 12 of POCSO Act and 4 of TNPHW Act. On perusal of records, even on 14.08.2025, summons to this accused was served through I.O. and on 14.08.2025 Thiru. M.Sathiyaseelan advocate has filed memo of appearance for him and with condition as imposed by this court on 28.08.2025, this petitioner/accused was appeared on 28.08.2025 and on 28.08.2025 copies u/s. 230 BNSS furnished to him at free cost and the case posted for hearing of bothsides relates to framing of charge and on 22.09.2025, 16.10.2025 the petitioner/accused was called absent and on 31.10.2025 NBW was issued against him due to his abscond and on 20.11.2025, this petitioner/accused was produced on NBW and is in judicial custody till date. Mean time, the charge has been framed on 09.12.2025 on 23.01.2026 L.W.2 was examined as P.W.1 and the case is pending for production of L.W.7 victim from 06.02.2026 till date and the case is posted on 18.03.2026.

Under section 35 of POCSO Act the trial of this case has to be completed with in a year and hence to secure the presence of the petitioner/accused during trial of this case and the evidence of victim yet to be recorded and at this stage, this Court is not inclined to release the accused on bail.

5. Hence this bail petition is dismissed.
