This petition is coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiruvargal. S.Sirajudeen, R.Thirunavukarasu, E.Dinesh, P.Thirugnanam, K. Sarumathi, M. Rohini, C. Yazhini and E. Sathish legal aid defense counsels for the petitioner and of Special Public Prosecutor for the state and upon hearing both sides, perusing the petition and other relevant records, this court delivered the following:-

ORDER

This application 483(i)(b) have been filed by the petitioners to relax the condition imposed on him by order dated 02.03.2026 in CrI.M.P.No.214/2026 that he would appear daily once at 10.00 A.M. before the All Women police Station, Thanjavur until further orders in connection with in Cr.No.57/2025 registered for the offence u/S. 116(h) of BNS & 5(m) r/w 6 of POCSO Act.

On service of notice through Investigation officer, the defacto complainant, who is the mother of the victim was present and filed her written objection and stated that if the accused released on relaxation bail her daughter is afraid of him and she strongly objected to release the accused.

The learned Special Public Prosecutor submitted IO's reply and strongly objected and he stated that the accused has been comply the condition 06.03.2026 to till date and the case was taken on file in Spl.S.C.No.5/2026 and the case is posted for production of LW2(victim) till 19.02.2026 02.04.2026 and if the petitioner/accused is released bail, he will abscond without appearing before this Court and he will abscond and he will tamper the witnesses and therefore, he strongly objected to the grant of bail.

On perusal of record and that the investigation is at initial stage and this Court considered that this petitioner/accused was released as per the order of this Court in CrI.M.P.No.214/2026 dated 02.03.2026 and now this petition is filed with stating that due to long distance from his residence to the AWPS, Thanjavur he is facing much difficult to comply the said order in time and he is in senior citizen and hence the said condition as imposed has to be modified. The Spl.P.P. and IO objected for the same. This Court ordered in CrI.M.P.No.214/2026 dated 02.03.2026 with the said condition to safe guard the interest of the victim girl and to avoid the petitioner/accused to tamper the witnesses. Hence this Court considered the age of the petitioner as he is 75 years old and ordered for modification in condition imposed in bail application of this petitioner in CrI.M.P.No.214/2026 dated 02.03.2026.

In the result, this petition is allowed with the modified conditions as follows,

(a) that the petitioner shall appear before the Samayapuram Police Station, Samayapuram daily once at 10.00 a.m. until further orders.

(b) the petitioner should produce proof for his permanent address.

(c) that the petitioner shall not threaten the victim or their family and that the petitioner shall not tamper the witnesses

(d) that the petitioner shall not hamper the investigation.

(e) that the petitioner should not leave India without intimation to this Court.
