This petition coming on this day before me for order in the presence of Thiruvallargal. P. Kamarasu and P. Chandrakumar Advocates for the petitioner and the Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides, this Court has delivered the following...

ORDER

This petition has been filed U/s.483 of BNSS for grant of bail to the petitioner for the offences U/S. 24 (1) COTPA Act 2003 and 77 of the Juvenile Justice Act 2015.

2. The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused stated that the dated of Occurrence took place on 04.03.2026 and that he was remanded in judicial custody on 04.03.2026 by the Judicial Magistrate Court No.1, Perambalur and he is innocent and he is poor and coolie and no bail petition before the Hon'ble High Court at Madras.

3. Reply received. The learned Public Prosecutor has argued that the petitioner is having Cool Lip bundles 111 in total weight 11.189 kgm and that case property was recovered and that the case is under investigation the evidence seized from the accused has to be sent to the Regional Forensic Science Laboratory

through the Court for analysis and a report has to be obtained and if the accused is released on bail he will abscond and he will tamper the witnesses and he will commit again the same offence and he strongly objected to release the accused on bail..

4. Heard both sides. On perusal of records, though FIR was registered on 04.03.2026 this petitioner/accused was remanded on 04.03.2026 and also considered that Cool Lip bundles 111 in total weight 11.189 kgm and that case property have to be remanded before the Judicial of Magistrate No.1, Perambalur and as per the IO's reply the investigation still pending and also considered the learned Public Prosecutor has seriously objects to grant of bail to the petitioner and if he released he may commit the same offence again and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence the petition is dismissed.

5. In the result, the bail petition is dismissed.
