Order Pronounced.

This application has been filed by the petitioners/4th & 5th defendants to receive documents on their side.

2. Now the suit is in the stage of further defendants side evidence. The petitioners/4th & 5th defendants contended that the documents which they seek to file on their side could not be filed when they have filed written statement and additional written statement for the reason that these documents were required by them at that stage. Therefore, they were not able to file them before this Court.

3. The respondent/plaintiff contended that they did not state any valid reason for not filing of those documents along with written statement and additional written statement and therefore, he is having objection in allowing this petition.

4. Refusing the petitioners/4th & 5th defendants from filing documents on their side could amount to shutting off their evidence and much prejudice will be caused to the petitioners/4th & 5th defendants if this application is dismissed. However, no prejudice will be caused to the respondent/plaintiff if this application is allowed.

5. Further the validity, veracity and evidentiary value of the documents could be tested at the time of marking of the documents and after conclusion of trial. Therefore in the interest of the justice, this Court is of the considered view that this petition can be allowed.

6. In the result, this petition is allowed. No cost.
