These petitions came up today before this Court in the presence of Thiru.P.Sakthivel, Advocate for the petitioners in Crl.M.P.Nos.586/2026 and 587/2026 and Thiru.P.Senthilnathan, the Public Prosecutor for the State and after careful consideration of the materials available on record and upon the submissions made on behalf of the parties, this Court has delivered the following...

COMMON ORDER

Since both petitions arose out of one and the same crime number, this Court decides to pronounce common order.

1. These two petitions U/S.482(2) of BNSS filed through online/e-filing mode for modification of the condition imposed in Crl.M.P.No.532/2026, dated 12.06.2026.

2. Heard, the learned counsel for petitioners and the learned Public Prosecutor.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners/Accused submitted that this Court has already granted anticipatory bail to the petitioners in CrI.M.P.No. 532/2026, dated 12.06.2026 on condition that the petitioners accused shall appear and sign before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. for a period of 30 days. They are complying the condition from 12.06.2026 to till date without fail for the past 18 days. The petitioner/A9 is a college going student and conduct the examinations and the petitioner/A3 is a engineer at PWD Contract in Sasta Enviro Tech Equipment and they have produced the identity cards are perused the same. It is difficult them to follow this condition regularly now filed this petitions prayed to modigy the bail condition imposed on the petitioners.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed stating that the petitioners have complying the condition for the past 18 days .

5. This Court carefully considered the submissions made on either side. The petitioners in CrI.M.P.No.586/2026 and 587/2026 were granted with the anticipatory bail in CrI.M.P.No.532/2026, dated 12.06.2026 and they directed to appearing and sign before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. for a period of 30 days. The petitioner in CrI.M.P.No.586/2026 claimed to be a student of law decree has produced the document to appear in the examination. The petitioner in CrI.M.P.No.587/2026 has also produced his identity card stating that he is working as a site engineer under a PWD contract at Sashta Enviro Tech Equipment, Pudhucherry. They have duly complied for the condition for the past 18 days. Considering their compliance with the conditions imposed by this Court, the academic prospects of the

petitioner in CrI.M.P.No. 586/2026 and nature of the job of the petitioner in CrI.M.P.No. 587/2026, both petitions are allowed.

6. In the result, the both petitions are allowed. Consequently, the condition is modified to extent that the petitioners shall appear on summon.
