Order Pronounced.

This application is filed to condone the delay of 26 days in filing the claim petition for the death of one Vadivel.

2. The reason for the delay stated by the petitioner is that he was affected from jaundice and because of living in other district and it was not possible to immediately file a petition for compensation and therefore, the delay of 26 days occurred.

3. The respondent contended that the reason alleged by the petitioner is not acceptable one and this petition is filed only to drag on the proceedings. The number of days delay is only 26 days and much prejudice will be caused to the petitioners than that of the respondent. Therefore, with a view to give an opportunity to the petitioners to contest the case on merits, this Court is of the view that the delay can be condoned.

4. In the result, this petition is allowed. No cost.
