This petition came up before me on 11.03.2026 for inquiry in the presence of Thiru.E.Sathish, Learned Legal Aid Defense Counsel for Petitioner and Learned APP Gr-II appearing for State upon heard the both side arguments and perused the material available on records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following,

ORDER

1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner U/s.480 of BNSS seeking for bail alleged offence U/s. 303(2), 317 of BNS.
2. The petitioner/accused counsel contended that the petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 06.03.2026 U/s. 303(2), 317 of BNS. At the

time of petitioner/accused judicial custody in another case in Cr.No.5/2026, Cr.No.11/2026, Cr.No.19/2026, Cr.No.21/2026, Cr.No.22/2026 Maruvathur Police Station on 10.02.2026. Petitioner/accused being in custody for a total of 28 days till this application. The petitioner/accused is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged. The complaint and F.I.R are completely false and a foisted case. In the F.I.R and complaint itself there is not mention of the accused name. There is no CCTV footage for occurrence. The property had been recovered there is no need of further investigation. The petitioner/accused has no previous history of criminal involvement. This is purely put up case filed against the petitioner. The petitioner is sincerely cooperating with the investigation and undertakes to continue cooperating with the trial proceedings without any default. The petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient and solvent sureties to the satisfaction of this Court. The continued dentention of the petitioner will cause irreparable loss and hardship to him and his family, who are soley dependent on him for their livelihood. The petitioner will not abscond, tamper with evidence, or influence any witness in any manner. Therefore, the petition may be allowed.

3. Whereas the prosecution submitted reply stated that strongly objected to grand bail to this petitioner/accused and the investigation is still pending. This petitioner/accused had already involved in various offences in various crime numbers. If the petitioner/accused released on bail, there are many chances to

do the same act and he will abscond and tamper the witnesses and it is difficult for the police to secure him again. Hence, the petition may be liable to be dismissed.

4. Heard both sides. Records perused. Case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is working as Assistant Engineer in Perambalur North Electricity Board. On 10.10.2025 at night, the unidentified persons stolen Transformer Oil-200 Kilo Ltr. and Copper Coil 120 Kg. from Alambadi Transformer No.13, the defacto complainant lodged a complaint before the respondent police. The accused was in judicial custody at Trichy Central Prison, confession given by the co-accused, this accused was involved in the above said Crime number, respondent police formally arrested the accused at Trichy Central Prison and produce before this court under P.T. warrant on 06.03.2026. The petitioner/accused is in judicial custody for the past 6 days. However, the reply given by the prosecution and circumstances of this case, investigation is still pending and the petitioner/accused has involved five criminal cases in Maruvathur Police Station. If the petitioner will be enlarged on bail, then it will be prejudiced the prosecution case. Hence, this court not inclined to allow this petition and liable to be dismissed.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
