This petition came up before me on 03.06.2026 for inquiry in the presence of Thiru.P.Kamarasu, Learned Advocate for Petitioner and Learned APP Gr-I appearing for State upon heard the both side arguments and perused the material available on records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following,

ORDER

1.The present application for bail under Section 480 of BNSS has been filed by the accused person in Crime No.77 of 2026 under Sections 4(1)(C), 4(1)(A) of TNP Act, on the file of the respondent police. A gist of the case of the prosecution is that the on 26.05.2026, the petitioner/accused was in illegal possession of 130 Black Pearl Brandy bottles and 9 Golden Eagle Brandy bottles at Kavulpalayam MBC Colony Village for the purpose of sale.

2. According to the counsel for the accused person, the accused person is innocent and is ready to offer adequate sureties. The prosecution strongly objected to the grant of bail by stating that the accused persons may get involved in other crimes if released.

3. Heard both side and records perused. The accused persons were remanded to judicial custody on 26.05.2026. The petitioner/accused has been in judicial custody for the past 9 days. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, this court inclined to allow this petition.

4. In the result, this petition is allowed on subject to the following conditions:

- a) The Petitioner ordered to be released on bail on her executing a bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- with 2 sureties.
- b) The sureties shall affix their photograph and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the sureties shall produce the copy of their Adhaar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.
- c) The petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily once at 10.00 a.m. for 15 days.
- d) The petitioner is directed to co-operate the investigation and shall not tamper the evidence.

In the result, this petition is allowed.
