This petition came up before me on 03.06.2026 for inquiry in the presence of Thiru.M.Rajkumar, Learned Advocate for Petitioners and Learned APP Gr-I appearing for State upon heard the both side arguments and perused the material available on records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following,

ORDER

1.The present application for bail under Section 480 of BNSS has been filed by the accused persons in Crime No.75 of 2026 under Sections 4(1)(C), 4(1)(A) of TNP Act, on the file of the respondent police. A gist of the case of the prosecution is that

on 23.05.2026 at 16.30 P.M., the petitioners/accused prepared, were in illegal possession also engaged in sale of 15 Ltr. local liquor (Nattu Sarayam) at Ammapalayam Kattukottagai.

2. According to the counsel for the accused persons, the accused persons are innocent and are ready to offer adequate sureties. This is allegedly the first bail application filed before this Court. The prosecution strongly objected to the grant of bail by stating that the accused persons may get involved in other crimes if released.

3. Heard both side and records perused. The accused persons were remanded to judicial custody on 26.05.2026. On perusal of records, it is seen that no person was hospitalized after consumption of the liquor sold by the petitioners/accused. The petitioners/accused are in judicial custody for the past 9 days. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, this court inclined to allow this petition.

4. In the result, this petition is allowed on subject to the following conditions:

- a) The Petitioners ordered to be released on bail on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- each with 2 sureties.
- b) The sureties shall affix their photograph and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the sureties shall produce the copy of their Adhaar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.
- c) The petitioners shall appear and sign before the respondent police station

daily once at 10.00 a.m. for 15 days.

- d) The petitioners are directed to co-operate the investigation and shall not tamper the evidence.

In the result, this petition is allowed.
