This petition came up before me on 03.06.2026 for inquiry in the presence of Thiru.M.Rajkumar, Learned Advocate for Petitioners and Learned APP Gr-I appearing for State upon heard the both side arguments and perused the material available on records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following,

ORDER

1.The present application for bail under Section 480 of BNSS has been filed by the accused persons in Crime No.281 of 2026 under Sections 296(b), 308(4), 351(3)

of BNS, on the file of the respondent police. A gist of the case of the prosecution is that the on 20.05.2026 at 7.00 P.M., the accused persons approached the de-facto complainant and asked for money in a public place and later uttered obscene words as against him, attacked and criminally intimidated him to take Rs.3,200/- from him, when he denied to give money.

2.According to the counsel for the accused persons, the accused persons are innocent and are ready to offer adequate sureties. The prosecution strongly objected to the grant of bail by stating that the investigation is not over and that the accused persons may get involved in other crimes if released.

3.Heard and records perused. This is second bail application. The accused persons were remanded to judicial custody on 21.05.2026. Except offence under Section 308(4) of BNS, other offences are bailable in nature. The petitioners/accused are in judicial custody for the past 14 days. Considering the age of the petitioners and considering the period of judicial custody undergone by the petitioners/accused, this court inclined to allow this petition.

4.In the result, this petition is allowed on subject to the following conditions:

- a) The Petitioners ordered to be released on bail on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- each with 2 sureties.
- b) The sureties shall affix their photograph and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the sureties shall produce the copy of their Adhaar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

- c) The petitioners shall report and sign before the Court every Monday, once at 10.00 a.m. for three months and before the respondent police daily once at 8.00 a.m., for 15 days.
- d) The petitioners are directed to Co-operate the investigation and shall not tamper the evidence.

In the result, this petition is allowed.
