This petition is coming up today before me in the presence of Thiruvallargal. P. Mohandas M. Mohammed Rasul, R. Menaka Priya Devi, counsels for the petitioner and Special Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides, perusing the petition and other relevant records, this Court delivered the following:-

ORDER

This application U/s.483(1)(b) of B.N.S.S has been filed by the petitioner to modify the condition imposed on him in the order dated 30.04.2026 in Crl.M.P.No.440/2026, by this court. Accordingly, he shall appear and sign before the All Women Police Station cantonment, Trichirapalli daily at 10.00 am until further orders.

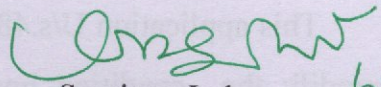
2. The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused would submit that the petitioner is released on bail and complying with the conditions by appearing before the All Women Police Station cantonment, Trichy daily at 10.00 A.M till date without fail and he is innocent and the petitioner is an 71 years old senior citizen suffering from old age ailments and prayed the conditions may be modified.

3. The learned Special Public Prosecutor strongly objected that the petitioner/accused has been complying with the condition from 21.05.2026 to 04.06.2026 for the period of 15 days and that the victim and the accused are same village and if the accused is released on modification of condition he will threaten and tamper the witnesses and prayed that the petition may be dismissed.

4. On perusal of records, as per the order in Crl.M.P.No 440/2026 dated 30.04.2026 the petitioner has been appearing before All Women Police Station cantonment, Trichirapalli at 10.00am for 15 days from 21.05.2026 to 04.06.2026. At this stage the present petition has been field to modify the condition. This Court is of the view that there is no valid reason stated to modify the condition. Therefore, he is directed to comply with the condition till 19.06.2026.

In the result, this petition is allowed. Accordingly, the condition is modified to an extent that the petitioner shall appear before the All Women Police Station, Cantonment Trichirapalli daily at 10.00 A.M to till 19.06.2026.
