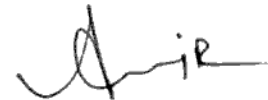

That you accused Laxminarayan Temple Kandivali (West), drove your vehicle or rode on a public way in a manner so rash and negligent as to endanger human life, or to be likely to cause hurt or injury to any other person, and thereby committed an offence punishable u/s. 281 of BNS and within my cognizance.

That you accused on the aforesaid date, time and place, drove your vehicle from wrong side of vehicular traffic so rashly and negligently as to endanger human life or the personal safety of others and thereby committed an offence punishable u/s. 125 of BNS and within my cognizance.

That you accused on the abovesaid date, time and place, drove your vehicle in a manner which is dangerous to the public, having regard to all the circumstances of case and thereby committed an offence punishable u/s. 184 of Motor Vehicles Act.

Particulars of plea is read over and explained to accused in the language known to him.

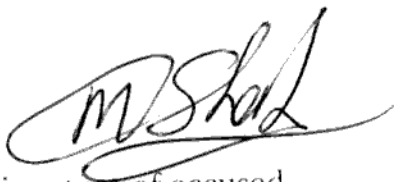

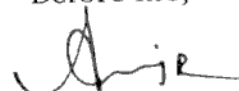

JUDGMENT

Accused appeared before Court. Particulars of offence are read over and explained to him to which he pleaded guilty. His plea is accepted as it appears to have been made voluntarily. Accused prayed for leniency. Ld. APP submits that maximum punishment may be imposed. Considering the submissions made by both sides, I pass the following order.

ORDER

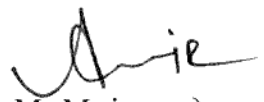
1. Accused viz. Minesh Chandulal Shah is hereby convicted vide Section 275 of BNSS of the offences punishable U/sec. 281, 125 of BNS and Section 184 of Motor Vehicles Act.

2. Accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 1000/- i.d. to suffer S.I. for 5 days for the offence p/u/s 281 of BNS.
3. Accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 1,500/- i.d. to suffer S.I. for 2 days for the offence p/u/s 125 of BNS.
4. Accused is sentenced to pay fine of 2000/- i.d. to suffer S.I. for 7 days for the offence p/u/s 184 of M. V. Act.
5. His bail bonds, if any, stand cancelled. The amount of cash surety, if any, be refunded to the accused forthwith.
7. Seized property, if any, be returned to the owner, on due identification and verification.
8. Copy of judgment be given to accused forthwith free of cost.
