This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru.R.Dharmalingam, Learned Advocate appearing for the Petitioner and the Learned Public Prosecutor Thiru.B.Venkatesan, on behalf of the Complainant and this Court passed the following,

ORDER

This petition is filed by the petitioner praying to relax the condition imposed on them by this court as per order passed in Cr.M.P.No.284/2026 before this court.

Notice was issued. Reply was filed by the prosecution.

It is submitted by the Learned Counsel for the petitioner that the petitioners were granted bail by an order of this court on 05.01.2026 with the condition to appear sign before the Judicial Magistrate I Pudukkottai daily at 10.30 am for fifteen days. It was modified to the effect that the petitioners shall report and sign before the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Gandharvakkottai once in a week in every Monday at 10.30

am. until further orders instead of the Judicial Magistrate No-1, Pudukkottai daily at 10.30am. The petitioners have been appearing and signed District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Gandharvakkottai once in a week in every Monday at 10.30 am without fail from 03.02.2026 till date without any deviation. It is further submitted on the side of the petitioners that the A1 and A2 are aged persons and A3, A4 are working as daily wages and they are the breadwinner of their family that they have no income due to the complying of the conditions and hence, they pray to relax the condition totally.

The Learned Public Prosecutor has fairly conceded that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly 03.02.2026 and he has no objection to relax the condition.

By considering the above submissions and in view of the period of compliance of the condition by the petitioners, the condition is relaxed in toto.
