This petition was filed through CIS and came before me on this day in the presence of Thiru.S. Kaleeswaran, B.A.,B.L.,for the Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/ Accused and of Thiru. M. Senthilkumar,B.A.,B.L., Learned Special Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant, upon hearing both side this court after perusing the records passed the following:

ORDER

This petition has been filed u/s 483 of BNSS Act / 439 of Cr.P.C. to release the petitioner/accused on bail.

2. The Petitioner/Accused is alleged to has committed the offence u/s 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(C)25 ,29(1) of NDPS Act 1985 and he was remanded to Judicial Custody on 05.05.2026.

3. The Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that the petitioner/accused is an innocent and he has not committed any offences as alleged and that he was alleged to have found in possession of 135.000 Kg of Ganja and he has been in Judicial Custody from 05.05.2026 and that he was ready to obey any condition imposed by this court and that for his released on bail and hence it is prayed that he may be released on bail on any condition.

4. The learned Special Public Prosecutor has strongly objected to grant bail by filing written objection of the Respondent wherein and it is stated that the petitioner/accused in which is Commercial Quantity of Ganja is involved in this case and if he is released on bail he will abscond and he will commit similar kind of offences.

5. Heard both sides.

6. Considering the above the facts and circumstances of this case and that the 135.000 Kg of Ganja which is a Commercial Quantity is involved in this case and if enlarge the accused on bail, there is a fine chance to commit and repeat the same kind of offences, while on bail. Absolutely, no circumstance have been brought on record to satisfy the requirement of section 37 of the NDPS Act. This court is find no reason to entertain this petition without any substantial ground. Considering the Serious offence by the prosecution and offence against society that this court is not inclined to allow this petition.

7. In the result, this petition is dismissed.
