This two petitions were filed through CIS and came before me on this day in the presence of Thiru.P.Sathasivam, B.A.,B.L., Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused in Cr.M.P.No.1305/2026 and of Thiru.A.Ramkumar, B.A.,B.L., Counsel for the Petitioners/Accused in Cr.M.P.No.1326/2026 and of Thiru.M.Senthilkumar, B.A.,B.L., Learned Special Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant, this court after perusing the records passed the following:

COMMON ORDER

This two petitions have been filed u/s 483 of BNSS Act /439 of Cr.P.C. to release

the petitioners/accused on bail.

2. The Petitioners/Accused were alleged to have committed the offence u/s 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(B),25 of NDPS Act 1985 and they were remanded to Judicial Custody on 17.04.2026.

3. The Learned Counsel for the petitioners/accused would submit that the petitioners/accused are innocent and they have not committed any offences as alleged and that they are alleged to have found in possession of 1.500Kg of Ganja and they have been in Judicial Custody from 17.04.2026 and that they are ready to obey any condition imposed by this court and that for their released on bail and hence it is prayed that they may be released on bail on any condition.

4. The Learned Special Public Prosecutor has strongly objected to grant bail by filing written objection of the respondent stating that previous cases are pending against the petitioners/accused and that if they are released on bail they will abscond and commit similar kind of offences.

5. Heard both sides.

6. Considering the above facts and circumstances of this case and that the petitioners/ accused were allegedly found to be in possession of 1.500 Kg of Ganja and that they have been in custody for the past 47 *days* and this court is inclined to release the accused on bail with condition.

7. In the result, the petitioners/accused are ordered to be released on bail on their executing a bond for sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for like sum to the satisfaction of this court on condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., for the period of Fifteen days.
